In 1997, a newly turned pro golfer named Tiger Woods shocked the world by winning his first Masters Tournament in Augusta, Georgia. Tiger shot the lowest 72-hole score in Masters history and, with a 12-stroke victory at age 21, became the youngest man ever to win the tournament. A child prodigy, Tiger Woods started playing golf at age 2 and invested years of hard work and dedication in order to excel in the game he loved. By 2008, Tiger had won 14 major tournaments and was counted among the greatest players ever. Then hardship came along – an 11-year drought plagued by back surgeries, knee operations and a troubled personal life – and it was generally assumed that Tiger's winning days were over. Tiger did not quit. In 2019, his drive to overcome resulted in a stunning comeback when he won the Masters for the fifth time. He now has won 15 major golf tournaments.

What if Tiger had not decided to keep pushing forward? It seems crazy to think that he might have quit. Most success does not come on a big stage with the world watching. But most success, the most meaningful success, does come by daring to try and then persevering. Tiger knew there were no guarantees, but he persevered and once again felt the joy of reaching his goal.

- *I want to put my toes in the ocean again.*



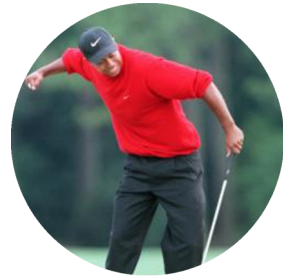
